

Scholarship Application for Graduating Texas High School Seniors

COUNCIL OF EDUCATIONAL FACILITY PLANNERS INTERNATIONAL (CEFPI) South Texas Chapter

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The South Texas Chapter of CEFPI will award a minimum of two \$2,000 scholarships to students planning to study in a field related to the Architecture, Engineering (i.e. Mechanical, Electrical, Civil, or Architectural, etc.) and Construction industry (AEC) as well as related disciplines such as Interior Design, Information Technologies, Computer-Aided Design, etc. as they relate to building design, construction and related careers.

CEFPI scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic record, achievement, leadership, career goals/interests, and performance at the personal interview.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a United States citizen and resident in the South Texas Chapter area: Bexar County, Comal County, Guadalupe County, Kendall County, Wilson County, Atascosa County, Medina County, Bandera County, or any other place within the Southern Region which is closest to this chapter and is not otherwise within the defined area of other chapters.
- Provide a completed scholarship application with all required attachments

 (Incomplete application packets will **not** be considered)
- Finalists will be required to participate in an in-person interview of approximately fifteen minutes in length which will be held in San Antonio, Texas.

Application Instructions:

- Complete the scholarship application form (attached).
- Secure and attach all required components of the application.
- Assemble the application in the following order:
 - o Application form with sections one through six completed
 - o Two recommendation letters from non-relatives in sealed envelopes
 - (teachers and/or employers preferred)
 - Official copy of SAT and/or ACT scores
 - Official transcript(s); no photocopies will be accepted

Develop and title your essay based on one of the following three questions:

- 1. What people and/or events in your life and/or what aspects of the AEC industry influenced your decision to select this career path?
- 2. Describe accomplishments that illustrate your aptitude for, and interest in, AEC-related fields.
- 3. Describe the learning environment in your school and/or any unique features in your educational experience that influenced your education. What would you want to change or improve for the next generation?

Note: Essays often serve as tiebreakers between closely-ranked applicants. A well-planned essay increases your chance of becoming a finalist.
